A special meeting of the Fairville Presbyterian Church session was called to order at 12:55. Elder Paul Salisbury, interim moderator, opened the meeting with prayer.

Elders present were: Carl Tack, Elaine Spross, Curt Richardson, Carol Brignall, and Stacey Weimer. Also attending were: Gladys Tack – Clerk of Session, and Pastor Joshua Baker.

The purpose of the meeting was to consider whether or not to exist as a Presbyterian church or to forgo that and move down the road as another faith community.

## Discussion:

There was no Special Congregation Meeting of the Fairville Presbyterian Church. The moderator was informed that many of the active members of the Fairville Presbyterian Church have expressed an intention to sever their relationship to that body.

Fairville session acknowledged Presbytery's willingness to explore options of continuing worship outside the Fairville church building, and graciously declined.

Fairville session has notified Pastor Joshua Baker that his services as a Temporary Supply Pastor at Fairville will be terminated effective August 11, 2015.

## Action taken:

The Session simply wishes to convey to General Council that they, as a body, have at no time undertaken a discussion much less a vote on the topic of dissolution. As individuals many are severing their relationship with the Fairville Presbyterian Church, and do not intend on attending the Fairville Presbyterian Church any longer.
