**Introduction to Systemic
Racism**

The purpose of this workshop is to explore racism as a system, institutional problem of power that goes beyond personal prejudice.

Participants will experience first-hand Crossroads' effective methodology for facilitating productive conversations about race. They will also be introduced to a strategic methodology that can assist people to effectively organize to dismantle racism in their institutions.

Our workshop leaders will be ministers who are trainer/organizers (one white and one non-white) from Crossroads Anti-Racism Organizing and Trainings.
