This document goes through the process step by step. You will need this as you work on the MDP, post it, and then use the CLC to find candidates for your position.

CLC Glossary of Terms & Processes

This document provides definitions of terms used plus explains what's new in the revised CLC. Can serve as a reference before and as you work with the CLC.

PDP Blank Form

The PDP (Personal Discernment Profile) is what call seekers submit to the CLC, along with their competency survey.

Guide to the Competency Survey & Match Criteria

The competency survey is what call seekers complete when they post their PDP (Personal Discernment Profile). Responses to the competency survey are compared to the match criteria values entered by the PNC to sort call-seekers on the basis of their "fit" to what the congregation is seeking in a pastor.
